

This year FABA is using BehaviorLive to broadcast our 2020 Virtual Event. BehaviorLive is a video platform used to host live CEU events for Behavior Analysts. This is a place for you to join live FABA events and connect with the FABA community. Scroll down to learn how you can join and engage in BehaviorLive events, and take full advantage of the specialized features the platform has to offer.

Join the FABA 2020 Virtual Event



You can join the FABA event by going to <u>https://behaviorlive.com/faba/home</u>

The cutoff to register for this event is September 11, 2020. If you attempt to log into BehaviorLive before that date, you may see a price of \$150 per event. Don't worry. Once the registrations sync with the BehaviorLive system, the prices change to show that you are registered. If you have not registered for the event, and it is after September 11, 2020, you can still register on the BehaviorLive website.

Registration

If you have already registered for the conference at fabaworld.org, you can log-in and create a BehaviorLive account. Note that a BehaviorLive account is separate from your FABA account.

Be sure to use the same email address you use for your FABA Account. BehaviorLive was given a list of email addresses that have paid, if you use a different email address, they system will prompt you to pay again.

If you did not register on fabaworld.org, you will need to register on the BehaviorLive website. Click the Registration button to step through the process. This is considered "on-site" registration.

Set up your Profile

Personalize your profile with a photo and brief bio, so other people know who you are! Head to: <u>behaviorlive.com/account/profile</u> to update your BACB Certificate Number, bio and headshot.



Note: You do not need to update your bio and headshot to use the BehaviorLive system, it is optional. You will need to verify your account in order to use all of the features of BehaviorLive. Be sure to check your email for a message coming from BehaviorLive Support <support@behaviorlive.com>

All of the presentations are listed in chronological order. When you find the event you want attend, click the title and you will be taken to the specific event.

If it is more than 20 minutes before the schedule start time, you will see a button that says it is not yet time to join.





When it is time to join, the button will change to "Join Now". Once you move to the presentation screen, you may see a graphic that says "currently off air". Don't worry, once the presenter is ready to begin, this will go away.

During live events, 4 "tokens" will appear on the screen at random times. Tokens are alphanumeric codes that display on the TOP of the screen. You have 3 minutes to type them into a box to verify that you are still there and paying attention. At the end of the event, when the presenter ends and closes his screen, you can print your CEU certificate. Each session will have it's own certificate.

If you would like to earn MH/PSY CEs, you need to send in a copy of each certificate to verify that you were there; Fill out an evaluation for each session you are requesting credit for and complete the payment form. Mail everything to Adapt Behavioral Services.

BACB CEUs are included in the price of a professional registration.

Interact in an Event

Polls are located in a tab just below the video feed. Your host may add a poll prior to the event or during a live session, so be sure to check this area periodically.

Questions & Answers are located in a tab just below the video feed. This is where you can submit any questions directly to the presenters.

Chat is located to the right of the video feed. This is a great place to say hello and introduce yourself before the event goes live. Chat lets you directly communicate with the host and other attendees before, during, and after an event.

Recorded Events

You can watch a recording of an event after it aired live. So if there is a session you would like to attend, but you have other commitments, you can go back any time before October 15th and watch it.). Just click the same event URL you used to register, or log into your account and go to My Courses.

If you watch a recording, there is a quiz at the end to verify you watched the presentation. It is a few questions about the presentation that might not be part of the main topic, but definitely something that was said.



Check your Tech Setup

For best quality results, it's good practice to check that your technical setup (e.g. browser, wifi connection) meets BehaviorLive requirements before joining an event. If you're expecting to join the event host on screen,

we recommend testing your audio/visual setup as well. Here's a helpful checklist to check your settings:

How to Collect CEUs

CEUs during a live event are super easy. Just follow these steps:

- 1. During a live event that is eligible for CEUs, you will see the CEU tab at the bottom of the screen.
- 2. **4** Tokens will Appear on the **TOP** screen during the event and will stay up for 120 seconds (2 minutes). An audio prompt will occur when the token appears. Type this token in the text box at the **BOTTOM** of the screen.
- 3. During the presentation, click the CEUs box and enter each token when it comes in
- 4. Once the presenter has ended and stopped the event, you can click "Complete Event" and get your certificate instantly.
- 5. If you are collecting MH or PSY CEs, print a copy of this certificate for each session and mail them along with evaluations and the payment form to Adapt Behavior.

If your certificate is missing your BACB number, you can go to "My Profile", add it, and re-generate your certificate.

Exhibits
